Head to NYC to see 2 games!

Have you ever wanted to see baseball in NYC? Here's your chance! Watch as St. Louis plays in the Bronx! We ride the subway to the stadium to avoid the massive traffic jams that occur on game days – as any New Yorker will tell you, it's the most efficient way to get to there! Plus, stay in Times Square at the Hotel Riu, visit the One World Observatory, and more. Don't delay, tickets are going fast!

Day 1: Aug 30: Head to NYC!



Meet Dea and Declan at St. Louis Lambert Airport. We board our afternoon flight to the Big Apple. We stay all 3 nights in Manhattan's Time Square, so there is plenty to do when not seeing the games. Enjoy a bit of touring and dining as we make our way to the hotel. The evening is yours to explore, and between the theaters, clubs, restaurants, and museums there's always something to do in NYC! **(D)**

Day 2: Aug 31: Let's Play Ball!

Meet our guide as we take the Subway up to the Bronx to see our first game at the state-of-the-art field, built in 2009. Today we sit in the premium club seats, located in left field and providing incredible views of the action. The included buffet has great reviews, so fill your plate and let's bring home a winner!

Afterwards we ride the subway back to Manhattan, where the rest of the day is free for you to explore.

Day 3: Sept 1: Second Innings!

We ride the subway with our guide, heading to the stadium for the second game. This time we are sitting in the infield seats, no bleachers for us! After a hopefully second win streak we hop on the subway and head back to Times Square. We visit the One World Observatory, located at the top of the New World Trade Center building, officially named One World Trade Center. Built after the Twin Towers were destroyed on 9/11, One World Trade soars to a symbolic height of 1776 ft tall. The Observatory has some of the best views of NYC and New Jersey. Afterwards we head to a local favorite Jewish deli, with some of the best sandwiches you will ever have. **(D)**

Day 4: Sept 2: One World Observatory and Homeward Bound

Check out of the hotel and board our motorcoach for a last bit of touring before we head home. Then it's time to bid farewell to the Big Apple and head to the airport and fly home. Thank you for traveling with us! **(L)**
