### June 5, 2025: Wings and Wine in the Willamette Valley

The rich soil of the Willamette Valley draws comparisons to the wine growing regions of

France and Napa Valley in California. It's also known for its scenic beauty. Following breakfast this morning at our hotel, we travel south into Willamette Valley and discover the **Evergreen**Aviation & Space Museum, home to Howard Hughes' amazing aircraft, the Spruce Goose, and other air and space artifacts. Lunch and time for shopping are provided in the quaint town of McMinnville. During your return to Portland, discover a charming winery and enjoy an included tasting. Dinner this evening is at your leisure, from any



number of restaurants nearby. Our local guide will provide you with several options. (B)

## June 6, 2025: Exploring the Columbia River Gorge



Travel into the heart of the **Columbia River Gorge** today, just east of Portland. You'll follow in the footsteps of famed explorers Lewis and Clark, who traveled overland to the Pacific Ocean, through the gorge in 1805. In the town of Hood River, travel by train on the **Mt. Hood Railroad**, amongst orchards of fruit trees in the shadow of its namesake mountain. A box lunch is included on board with a stop at the Fruit Company, a fourthgeneration, family-owned orchard. With funding from the Public Works Administration in 1934, Bonneville Dam was started on the mighty Columbia River. Laborers worked in non-stop eighthour shifts and were paid 50 cents an hour for their work on the dam. Completed in 1938, the dam still provides electricity for the City of Portland. Learn more at the visitor center and during a tour. Pause at Multnomah Falls, the highest waterfall in Oregon, before returning to Portland. **(B,L)** 

# June 7, 2025: Enjoy the Festival!

For over 100 years, the Portland Rose Festival's Grand Floral Parade has provided a unique experience!

After, enjoy a luncheon cruise aboard the **Portland Spirit** along the Willamette River. Pass by colorful houseboats and under several bridges with the city's downtown skyline providing an impressive backdrop. Heading north, cross the Columbia River, and pass by Mt. St. Helens and Mt. Rainier. Arrive in Seattle in the late afternoon. **(B,L)** 



# June 8, 2025: Exploring the Emerald City

Named for Chief Seattle, this city nestled along Puget Sound has much to share. Your first stop is the **Space Needle**. Built for the World's Fair in 1962, it remains Seattle's



most iconic sight. Drop into Dale Chihuly's **Garden of Glass** at the base of the Space Needle and see the artist's famous glass art installations, both inside and out! Enjoy lunch at your leisure from any one of several restaurants along the redeveloped waterfront or simply grab a cup of clam chowder and watch massive ferries as they provide service between Seattle and the countless harbors and islands around the sound! Pause at Pike Place Market and discover a plethora of local foods and

wares, including the original Starbucks Coffee.

For those of us continuing to the Rocky Mountaineer in Canada, we continue North to Vancouver, British Columbia. Otherwise you will fly home to Saint Louis from here. Thank you for traveling with us!!

A **deposit of \$1,000** per person is due when signing up for this tour. Final Payment is due April 21, 2025. Multiple payments and types of payment are accepted towards the tour.

We have over 30 people requesting this tour. If you want to go, please call our office and you can also email you want to go. We will allow 7 days for your check to arrive or you can pay with credit card at the above rate. We are working in a new system called Group Collect. You may pay online with credit card too but receive no discount. If you enter your own bank account info and pay it then receive a 1.8% discount off the price.

We encourage trip interruption and cancellation insurance. You will want to send that with your deposit so as to cover pre-existing conditions. We are also offering coverage through TripMate in conjunction with GroupCollect and can begin offering it on tours not previously booked. The pricing on group insurance is NOT based on age, just the price of the tour.

The individual is based on both age and price of tour. We can check for best fit. We also offer Cancel Any Time policies but they are often much more expensive and you receive 80% of what you paid for the tour if reason is not a covered reason. If it is covered, you will receive the full amount once the claim information has been filed and approved by the insurance company. It takes 8-12 weeks typically. Ask Maggie when you sign up.
